Black women played a pivotal role in the 2016 Democratic National Convention standing in the shoes of Fannie Lou Hamer, Shirley Chisolm and Barbara Jordan. In their own right, all of them made history during democratic conventions elevating Black women's voices and leadership.

From Baltimore's Mayor Stephanie Rawlings-Blake who gaveled in the 2016 Democratic National Convention (DNC) and Reverend Leah Daughtry serving as the Chief Executive Officer of the convention to the recent announcements of Donna Brazile as the Interim Chair of the Democratic National Committee and Congresswoman Marcia Fudge as the permanent chair to the 2016 Democratic National Convention, black women are leading the DNC.

Forty years this past September, First Lady Michelle Obama addressed the nation, continuing the legacy of the late Congresswoman Barbara Jordan, the first black woman keynote speaker at a Democratic Convention.
