Perhaps you have had the opportunity to participate in the on-line giving via our Fairfield Baptist Church website. For all those who have done so, we commend you.

The two new additional giving technologies will allow Fairfield to make it convenient for everyone to give at anytime and from anywhere. They have been put in place and are currently being beta tested here at Fairfield. You can make use of them now. The three technical methodologies include:

ONLINE GIVING:

Sign onto the fairfieldbaptistchurch.org website and follow the prompts.

TEXT GIVING:

Sign on to IPHONE Message using the number 770 285-0017. If you have not yet posted funds via texting, a one-time registration to submit your gift will be requested. After that all you have to do is post the amount you wish to give and send. You will be prompted with a message letting you know your transaction was successful. Be very careful to put your decimal where it belongs.

Health Tip - Heart Health

The heart works all the time. Following are some changes we can make in our everyday lives which can help prevent the heart from working harder and decrease the risk of Heart Disease:

- I. Get at least seven hours of sleep everyday
- 2. Avoid high blood pressure. Get blood pressure checked at least once a year (more often if it is already high)
- Watch amounts of saturated fats in your diet which are found in red meats, whole dairy products and fried or processed foods.
- Avoid or control diabetes
- Increase activity such as moderate exercise every day
- 6. Include more fruit, vegetables, nuts and seeds in your diet and less processed foods
- Maintain proper body weight. Eat healthy foods (less calories) and get more exercise
- No smoking. Second hand smoke is also bad for the heart
- Manage stress (A daily walk and talk with lesus really works)




