I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this *Parent's Code of Ethics* Pledge.

I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice, or other youth sport events.

I will place the emotional and physical well - being of my child ahead of a personal desire to win.

I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.

I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.

I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and will refrain from his/her use at all your sports events.

I will remember that the game is for youth - not adults.

I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.

I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and other officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.

I promise to help my child enjoy the youth sports' experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectful fan, assisting with coaching, or providing transportation.

I will require that my child's coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sport's coach and that the coach upholds the *Coaches' Code of Ethics*.

I understand and agree that any <u>unsportsmanlike conduct</u>, <u>profanity</u>, <u>and verbal or physical abuse of any team member or team member's property</u>, <u>FBC Family Life Center Staff</u>, <u>Coaches</u>, <u>Officials</u>, <u>or parent will result in my being asked to leave premises</u>, <u>until further notice from the Director</u> or such time as the Director may deem fair and necessary.
