

PARENT'S CODE OF ETHICS PLEDGE

Parents also should be held to a standard of behavior that provides a positive environment for their child's sport experience. The *Parent's Code of Ethics* should be read and signed by each parent of your players.

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this *Parent's Code of Ethics* Pledge.

I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice, or other youth sport events.

I will place the emotional and physical well – being of my child ahead of a personal desire to win.

I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.

I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.

I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and will refrain from his/her use at all your sports events.

I will remember that the game is for youth - not adults.

I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.

I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and other officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.

I promise to help my child enjoy the youth sports' experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectful fan, assisting with coaching, or providing transportation.

I will require that my child's coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sport's coach and that the coach upholds the *Coaches' Code of Ethics*.

I understand and agree that any unsportsmanlike conduct, profanity, and verbal or physical abuse of any team member or team member's property, FBC Family Life Center Staff, Coaches, Officials, or parent will result in my being asked to leave premises, until further notice from the Director or such time as the Director may deem fair and necessary.

I will remember that a sport is an opportunity to learn and have fun.
